This is insignificant in comparison to the 46,000 capacity that Eskom has at its disposal but the government has after all stalled all initiatives and efforts by the City of Cape Town and the private consumer over the last 10 years. If current and new initiatives are encouraged with the many self-sufficient consumers willing to feed their excesses into the grid then the Western Cape (followed the Eastern Cape) can be at least *self-sustaining as provinces*.
