

DStv Eutelsat Awards extends deadline for students to win a trip to Paris

The DStv Eutelsat Awards, which are open to all students from secondary (high) or combined schools in Africa where MultiChoice Africa maintains operations, have extended the entry deadline to 20 November 2015.



The competition calls all learners between the ages of 14 - 19 to write an essay or design a poster on how satellites have helped us to understand and take care of our planet.

The entry forms can be obtained from any MultiChoice Resource Centre, the nearest MultiChoice office or copies can be downloaded from www.dstvstarawards.com. Entries can be submitted in English, French and Portuguese. The awards collateral is also available in three languages (English, French and Portuguese). Only entries submitted on the prescribed entry form will be eligible.

Participants not only stand a chance to win great prizes within their respective countries but overall winners will be rewarded with a trip of a lifetime.

- **Overall winning essay** - a trip with his/her parent/legal guardian to Eutelsat in Paris, France and onwards to a spaceport to attend a live rocket launch
- **Overall winning poster** - a trip with his/her parent/legal guardian to Eutelsat in Paris and a satellite construction site
- **Runner-up poster and essay entries** - a trip with their parent/legal guardian to visit MultiChoice in Johannesburg and the South African National Space Agency at Hartebeesthoek

The winners will be announced at an awards ceremony in Uganda during February 2016.
