I caught up with the iconic Claire Johnston from Mango Groove, last week...

Hopefully just having a platform to communicate to others what you love and what is important to you and, hopefully, to move them in some way.

■ ***What does music mean to you?***

Memories, moments, a soundtrack to your life? It's got to be about what moves you.

■ ***What is the most enjoyable aspect of your work?***

■ ***Any funny moments on stage?***

We're a chaotic and spontaneous 11-piece on stage, so many funny and humiliating moments, and doubtless more to come.

Well, they are not possessions, they are wonderful beings who I am lucky enough to have gracing my life: my beloved fur-friends Sammy and Cloudy. We belong to each other.
