The show will open with the South African Music Awards 2019 winner, pianist Bokani Dyer and his trio, who will present *Neo Native* with Sphelelo Mazibuko on drums and Romy Brauteseth on bass. Dyer will be followed by the amazing soprano Zandile Mzazi, accompanied by Yohan Chun on piano and Francois Botha on Double bass. They will present work deeply connected with Mam Sibongile Khumalo's illustrious career.


