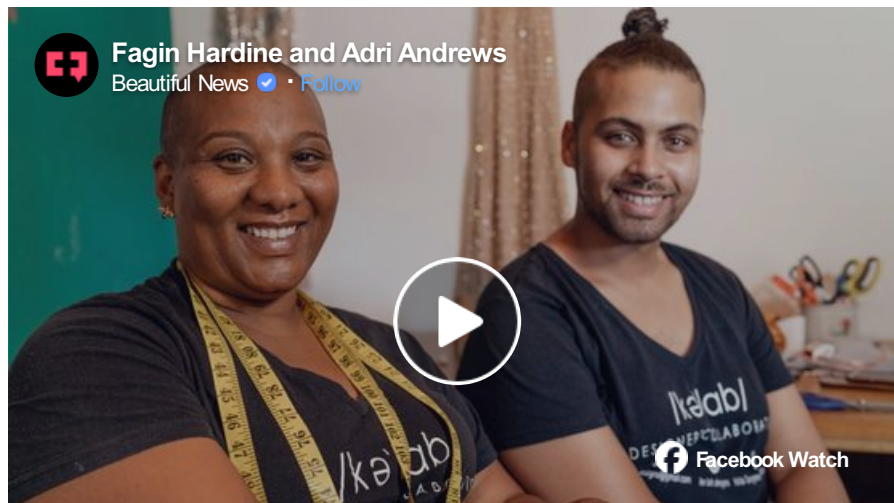


#BeautifulNews: These designers sew pride for matriculants
