

MTN CEO resigns following Nigeria fine fiasco

"MTN CEO Sifiso Dabengwa quits", reports <u>TimesLive</u>. This comes after <u>last week's news</u> that MTN's operating licence in Nigeria has been renewed for another five years.



Some were surprised to hear about the renewal as the company has to pay up a \$5.2bn fine for failing to disconnect unregistered sim card holders in the country - its largest country of operation by far - by 16 November.

The fine is the reason Dabengwa has resigned with immediate effect, explains **Business Report**.

Non-executive chairman Phuthuma Nhleko will serve as executive chairman for MTN in a temporary capacity for the next six months until a suitable replacement is found.
